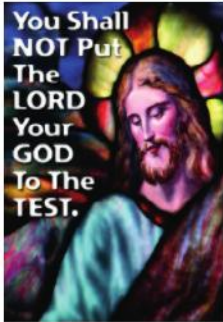


1ST Sunday of Lent

SVdP Annual Report to the Parish for Year 2015

The chart below summarizes the work of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul at St. Michael's over the past 12 months. Our conference of SVdP at St. Michael's assists those in need in the Lake Jackson, Clute and Richwood area providing food, financial assistance, counseling, spiritual and emotional comfort, etc.

Notes on columns:

"Groceries # bags" includes food during the year and the Thanksgiving baskets provided to 64 families in November. In total, 869 children and 945 adults were provided food during the year.

"Groceries & Food Cards" includes cost of food throughout the year to supplement donations to the pantry, and the cost of the Thanksgiving baskets and the small food cards distributed with them.

"Utilities" includes water, power, and gas.

"Other" includes all other expenses not fitting the previous categories, like transportation, parishioner elder care, non-food expenses of Thanksgiving baskets, donation to upper council etc.

The majority of funding for this work came from continued regular donations throughout the year from individuals and other ministries and from you our parishioners through the envelope collection in January. Without your help and generous contributions, we would not be able to continue this ministry. Thank you again for allowing us to be Christ's hands and feet for our neighbors.

Please continue to use the Kroger Share cards as they are an additional source of income for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. If you shop at Food King, we also collect Food King Receipts in the envelope on our bulletin board and the basket in the hallway of the Family Life Center.
