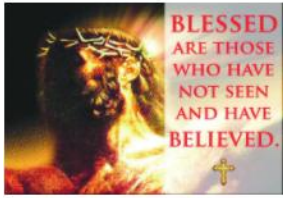


# *Divine* Mercy

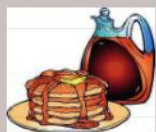
