

There are FOUR (4) CDA National scholarships available as outlined below. All applicants will compete at the National level. If you are interested or need other clarification, please e-mail me or call me (Mary Montague) at 979-418-1222 to obtain the applications & policies /procedures. All applications must be received no later than Friday, 4/22, 2016

<u>Father Leonard Bachmann Graduate Scholarships</u>-Two Graduate scholarships-A 1<sup>st</sup> place for \$3,000 and one 2<sup>nd</sup> place of \$1,000 will be awarded to an applicant (male or female) of Catholic Faith who is a member of the CDA or a relative of a current CDA member and who has COMPLETED UNDERGRADUATE studies and who desires assistance for tuition to continue studies on the graduate level. An application, official transcript, letter of academic reference, your reasons for applying & your autobiography are all requirements.

<u>Campus Court Scholarship</u>-One \$2,000 to a Catholic Faith member of a CDA Campus Court for tuition to continue studies at a college or university. Four requirements include: Class registration for fall semester, 2016; your autobiography; a letter from your campus court advisor & your reasons for applying.

National Scholarship for 8<sup>th</sup> grader entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2016. Two \$1,000. Requirements-1. You must be Catholic (male or female). You do NOT have to be a relative who is CDA member. 2. You must be attending a Catholic School in the fall, 3. An essay of ~ 250-300 words typed & double spaced entitled What are my God-given gifts and talents, and how will I share them in high school? Other requirements include a) list of church, community & school activities AND b) letters of character reference (non-relatives) from Priest, Deacon, Religious, or Catechetical leader and from your school or religious leader and from an adult (non-relative).

National JCDA Scholarship-(One \$1,000)- Awarded to a JCDA member entering College in Fall, 2016. Requirements-1. You must be Catholic & entering Freshman year in college 2. Must have been JCDA member for at least two years Immediately Preceding this application 3. An essay of 250-300 words typed & double spaced entitled What are my God-given gifts and talents, and how will I share them in college? Other requirements are exactly the same as the scholarship listed above.
