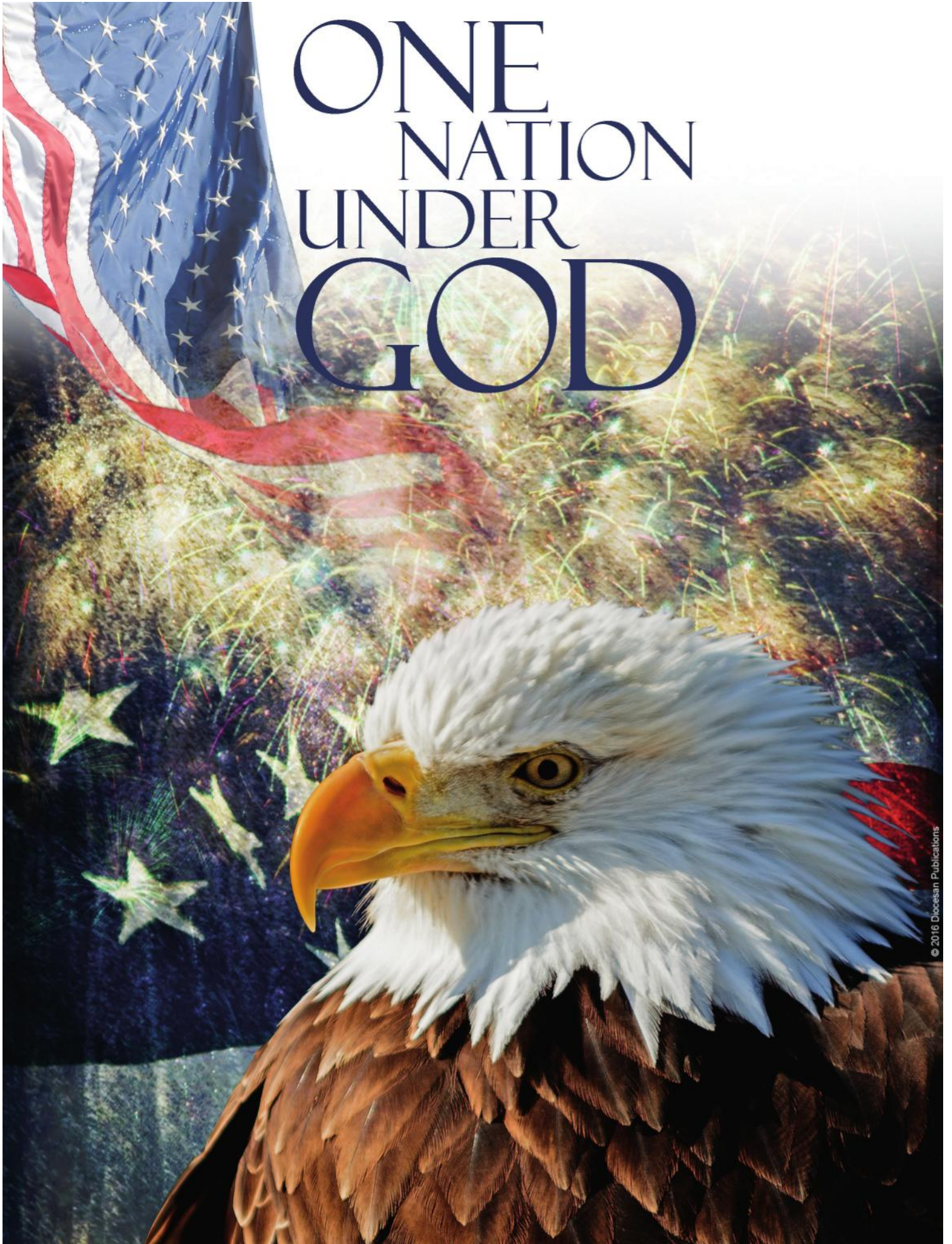
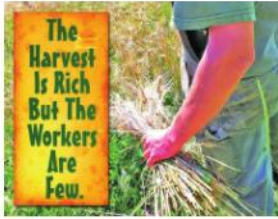


ONE NATION UNDER GOD


