

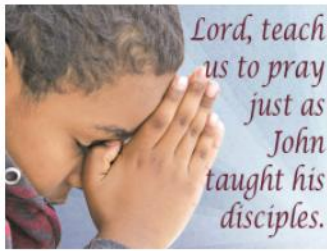

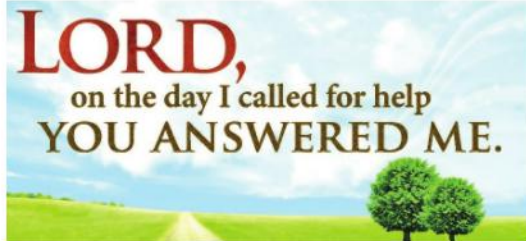




Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.

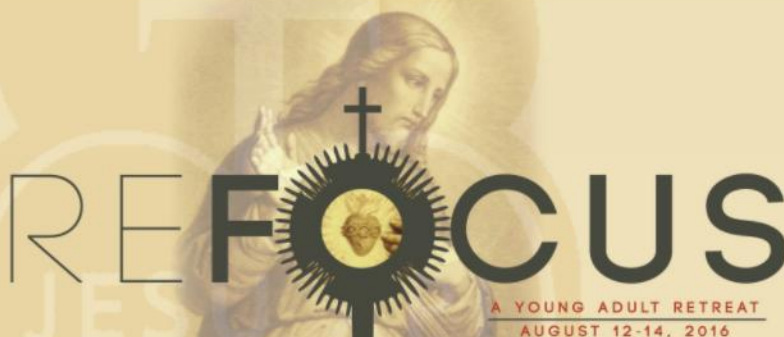
