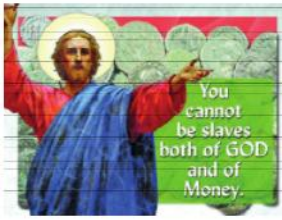
## THE PARABLE OF THE DISHONEST STEWARD
