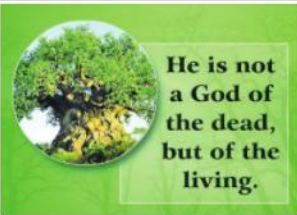
THE QUESTION ABOUT THE RESURRECTION

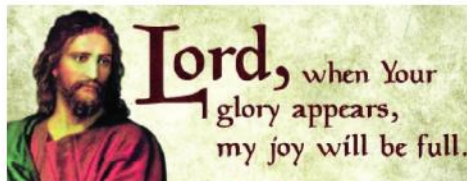




He is not
