

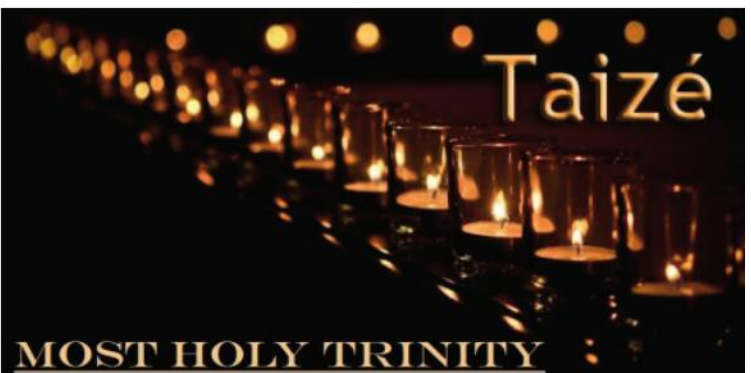

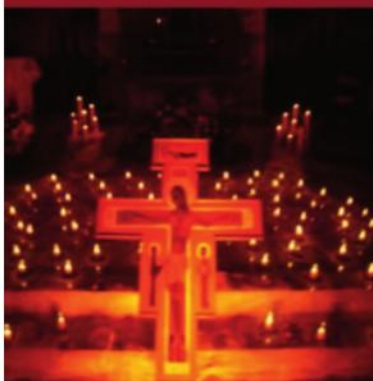
Evening Prayer
