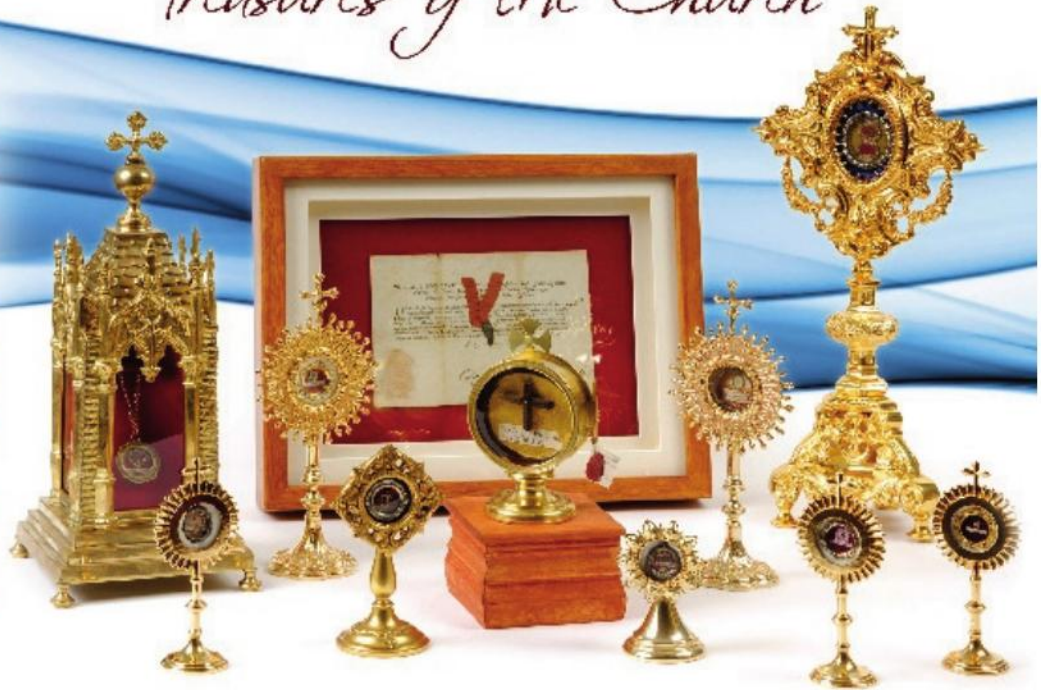
EXPOSITION OF SACRED RELICS
