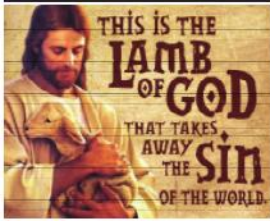

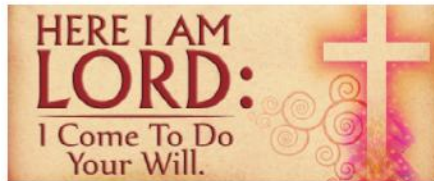
“Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away
