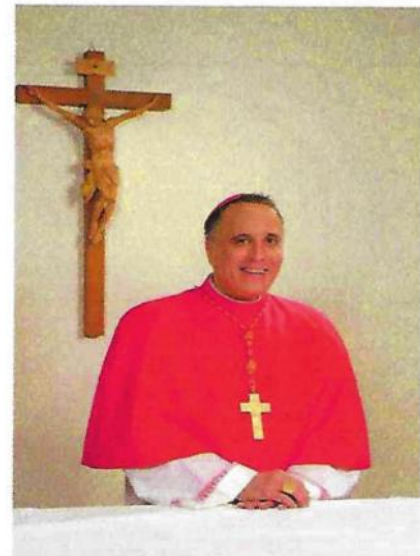
### IGNITE: *Our Faith, Our Mission* Begins!
