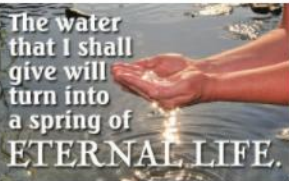

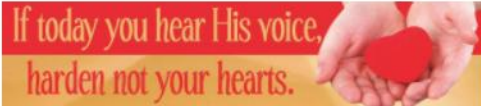
If today you hear his voice,

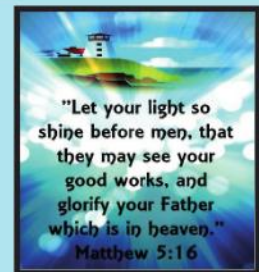
