

#### **Adoration Chapel Update**

#### Communal Prayer

The Chapel has reopened after a few modifications and is now in physical compliance with Vatican guidelines. Eucharistic Exposition is a communal rite and should be accompanied by communal prayer. As the Chapel opens and on the hour every hour until closing we will be joining in community prayer as is required for perpetual exposition of the Eucharist ("to ensure that each hour of prayer includes communal praying"). Deacon Gary has created a community prayer consisting of a scripture reading, song, and prayer. This is the and recommendation from Guide for Celebration: Worship Of The Eucharist Outside Mass. This practice is like the "passing of the prayer torch." There are laminated copies of the prayers for both the even and odd hours in English and Spanish placed on the podium in the Chapel. Please invite all who are visiting the Chapel to join in praying as a community before the Blessed Sacrament.

#### Statue of Mary

There has been much discussion about the statue of Mary in our Chapel. When the Director of Office of Worship visited our Chapel there were two things at the top of her list that needed to change. One was the sanctuary candle, which we have addressed and the second was the statue of Mary. It had to move back away from the altar. "Saints lead us to Christ; however, no saintly image should obscure or take precedence over Christ's presence in the Rite of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament." Guide for Celebration: Worship Of The Eucharist Outside Mass.

We are privileged to have Eucharistic Exposition daily in our Chapel. Exposition is what sets our Chapel apart from a prayer chapel. We are in the presence of Jesus. The statue is placed facing the altar to remind us where our focus should be.

Please do not move the statue as doing so takes us out of compliance with the guidelines given to us by the Vatican.






