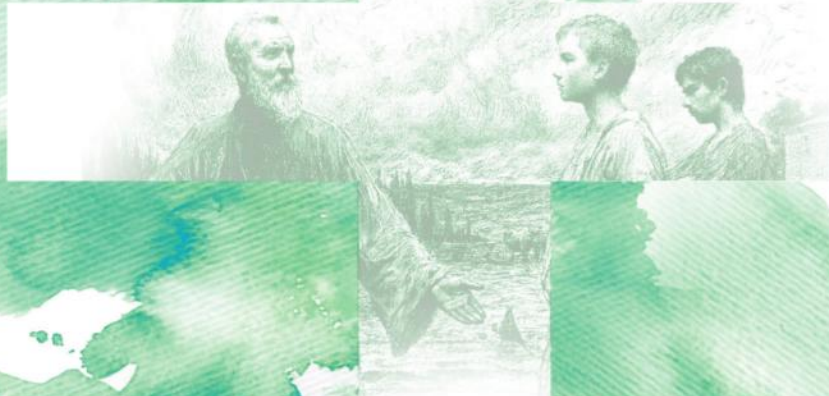


# TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY

## SIXTH FATIMA APPARITION AND THE MIRACLE OF THE SUN – OCTOBER 13, 1917

### PRAYERS FOR WORLD PEACE – OCTOBER 13, 2017



For the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal, Pope Francis has decided to grant a plenary indulgence opportunity throughout the entire anniversary year, which began Nov. 27, 2016, and will end Nov. 26, 2017.

On Friday, October 13, 2017, we will celebrate this special event of the Sixth and final apparition in Fatima. Prepare for this special occasion at our parish:

Reconciliation service.

- Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at 4:00 pm - 5:25 pm.
- Thursday, October 12, 2017 at 4:00 pm - 5:25 pm.

Holy Mass of Our Lady of Fatima.

- Friday, October 13, 2017 at 8:30 am.

The procession of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima will start after mass from the church going around the parking lot and the end at patio of Msgr. Leo Wleczyk Hall at 10:00.

Reception after that. Everyone welcome!

Three ways to obtain an indulgence for this special event:

1. Make a pilgrimage to the Fatima shrine in Portugal.
2. Pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory of proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017.
3. Applying to the elderly and infirm for reason of age, illness or other serious cause, are unable to get around. These individuals can pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima.

To obtain a plenary indulgence, the faithful must also fulfill the ordinary conditions: go to Confession and Communion, be interiorly detached from sin, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.
