

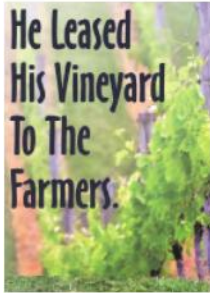

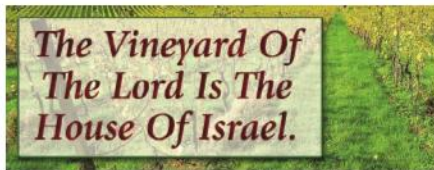
Therefore, I say to you, the

SIXTH FATIMA APPARITION AND THE MIRACLE OF THE SUN – OCTOBER 13, 1917

PRAYERS FOR WORLD PEACE – OCTOBER 13, 2017



For the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal, Pope Francis has decided to grant a plenary indulgence opportunity throughout the entire anniversary year, which began Nov. 27, 2016, and will end Nov. 26, 2017.

On Friday, October 13, 2017, we will celebrate this special event of the Sixth and final apparition in Fatima. Prepare for this special occasion at our parish:

Reconciliation service.

- Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at 4:00 pm - 5:25 pm.
- Thursday, October 12, 2017 at 4:00 pm - 5:25 pm.

Holy Mass of Our Lady of Fatima.

- Friday, October 13, 2017 at 5:30 pm.

The procession of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima will start after the 5:30 mass from the church going around the parking lot and end at the covered area of Msgr. Leo Wleczyk Hall at 7:30 pm

Reception after that. Everyone welcome!

Three ways to obtain an indulgence for this special event:

1. Make a pilgrimage to the Fatima shrine in Portugal.
2. Pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory of proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017.
3. Applying to the elderly and infirm for reason of age, illness or other serious cause, are unable to get around. These individuals can pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima.

To obtain a plenary indulgence, the faithful must also fulfill the ordinary conditions: go to Confession and Communion, be interiorly detached from sin, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Practicing Peace

Peace can be yours. It is hard to find peace in a busy life with many commitments, noisy neighbors, and angry streets. But peace can be yours.

Peace is as attainable as good health and good friendships. It requires work. But there is a formula. If you want good health you develop habits of eating and exercising. If you want good friends you work at relationships and practice selflessness. These goals require work, but they are within reach.

So is peace. St. Paul advises the Philippians to have no anxiety at all and to make their needs known to God. "Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."

That's it. Put anxiety away and make your requests known to God. If you have needs, do not dwell on them. Give them to God. Let God take it from there. Meanwhile, Paul says, think about what is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, gracious, and excellent—not about what you are lacking. When you practice peace by thinking of peaceable things, peace can be yours.

No one decides what goes into your mouth except you. You can diet if you want to. No one decides what friends you have except you. You can make and break relationships. No one decides what goes into your mind except you. You can think about the things that bring peace, and peace can be yours.
