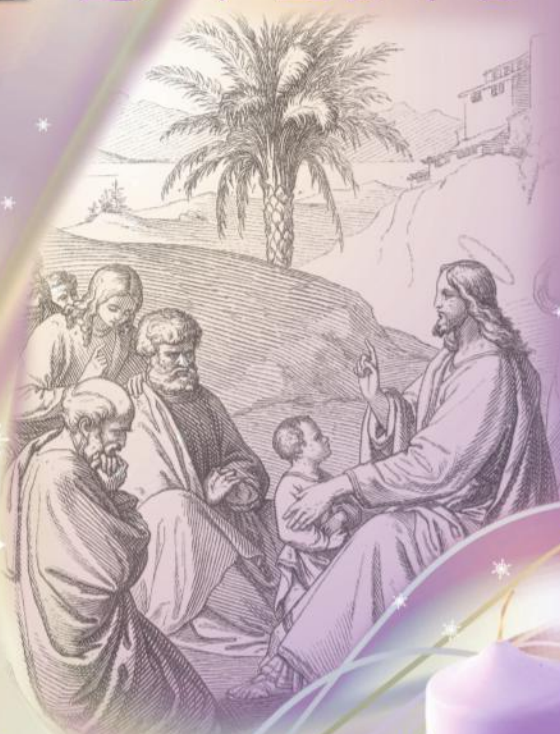

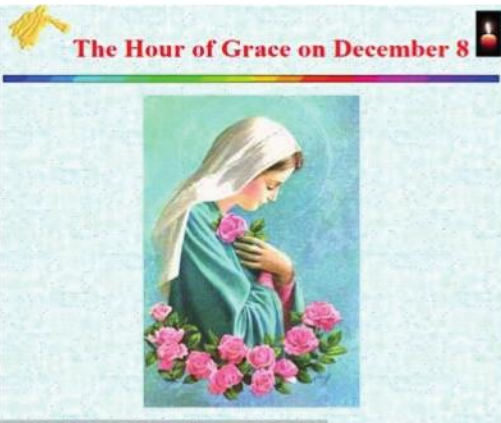

Request of Our Heavenly Mother for the Hour of Grace:

1. To be started from 12 noon until 1 p.m. (one full hour of prayer); in the Church
2. During this hour the person making the Hour of Grace either at home or in a church must put away all distractions;
3. Begin the Hour of Grace by praying three times the 51st Psalm with outstretched arms;
4. The rest of the Hour of Grace may be spent in silent communication with God, adoring the Sacred Host, meditating upon the Passion of Jesus, saying the Holy Rosary, praising God in your own way or by using favorite prayers, singing hymns, etc.



ADVENT SEASONAL DEVOTIONS

The season of Advent begins this weekend. We are encouraging our faithful to embrace two powerful devotions that can be used at home to help us focus on this holy time of waiting for the coming of Jesus: the **ADVENT WREATH** and the **JESSE TREE**.

Since the Middle Ages, the **ADVENT WREATH** has been used by Christians as part of their spiritual preparation for Christmas. The wreath consists of a ring, usually of evergreens, with four candles (3 purple and one rose). This is an excellent devotion for an individual or family and mealtime is a good time to pray this devotion.

A **JESSE TREE** is a tradition which recalls the family tree of Christ. On the tree we hang various symbols which trace the persons or events which lead to the birth of Christ. This is an excellent devotion for the Catholic home.

Our parish will be selling **ADVENT WREATH** and **JESSE TREE** materials at a very nominal cost. More information on setting up and observing these traditional Advent devotions are available on our parish website: www.smlj.org.

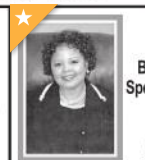
