ADVENT SEASONAL DEVOTIONS

TREE.

The season of Advent begins this weekend. We are encouraging our faithful to embrace two powerful devotions that can be used at home to help us focus on this holy time of waiting for the coming of Jesus: the ADVENT WREATH and the JESSE

Since the Middle Ages, the ADVENT WREATH has been used by Christians as part of their spiritual preparation for Christmas. The wreath consists of a ring, usually of evergreens, with four candles (3 purple and one rose). This is an excellent devotion for an individual or family and mealtime is a good time to pray this devotion.

A JESSE TREE is a tradition which recalls the family tree of Christ. On the tree we hang various symbols which trace the persons or events which lead to the birth of Christ. This is an excellent devotion for the Catholic home.

Paving a Direct Route

Whenever a highway changes from two lanes to four, you can often see the improvements. The old highway follows the dips and curves of the landscape. The new highway better controls the landscape. It is straighter and more level. The engineers have figured out how to improve the road, and citizens have supported the additional expense.

People like straight highways. They are quicker, safer and more pleasant.

In the prophecy of Isaiah, a voice cries out, "In the desert prepare the way of the LORD!" John the Baptist quoted this passage to prepare people for the coming of Jesus.

Make a straight highway in the wasteland. Fill in the valleys and lower the mountains. Make a smooth, direct road in your spiritual life.

During Advent we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ in our lives. In the past we formed habits as sturdy as two-lane roads. They get us where we want to go, but sometimes not by the most direct route.

We have only a few weeks till Christmas. It is time to move the roadblocks and detours that keep us from encountering Christ. Hardness of heart, stinginess of time, or unbending habits—Which of these need repair on your highway toward Christ?
