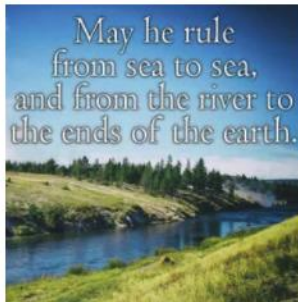


EPIPHANY

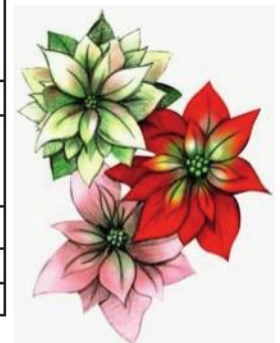
