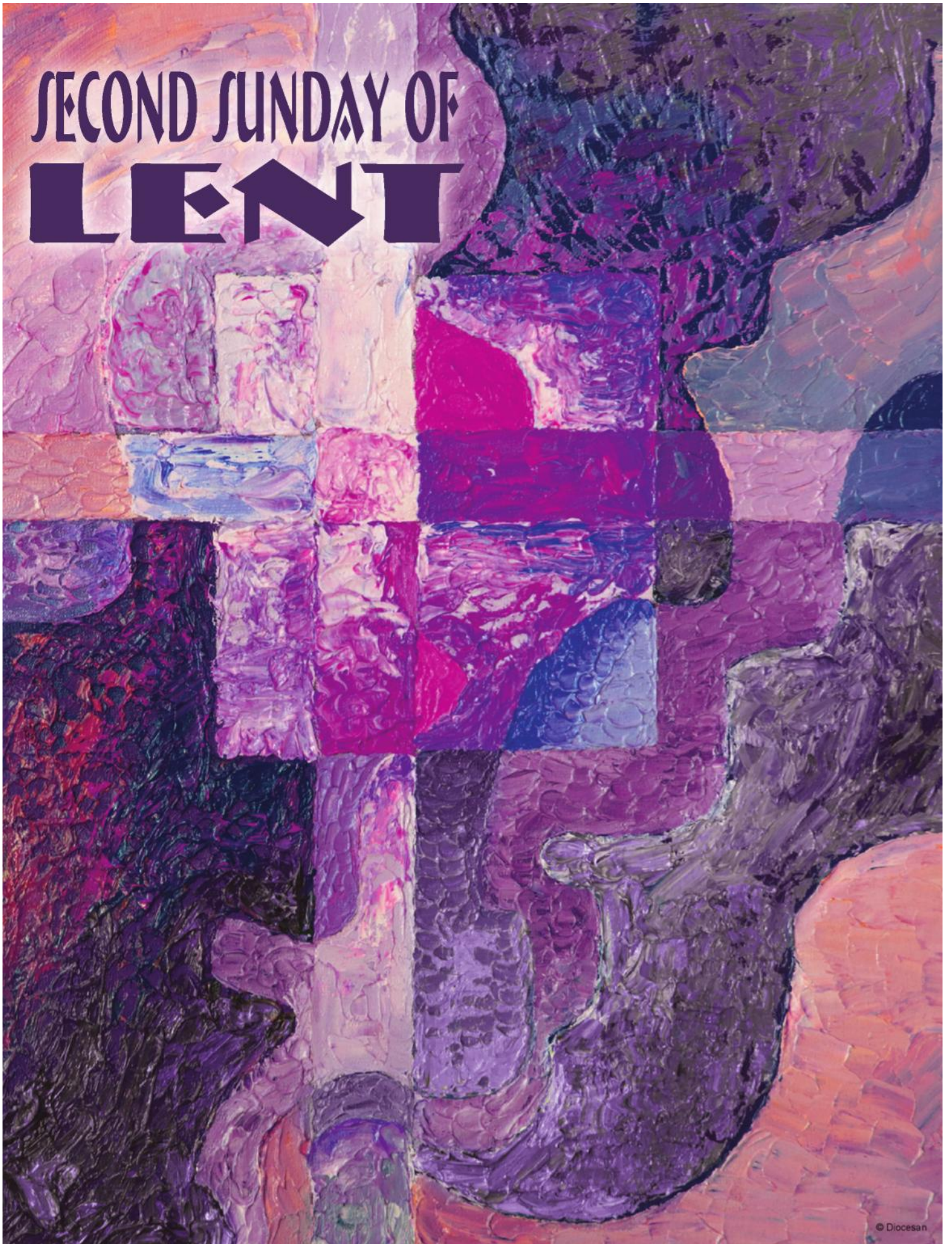
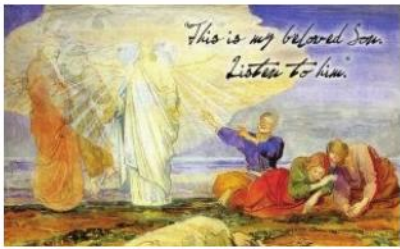


# SECOND SUNDAY OF **LENT**







As Jesus is transfigured before his disciples in today's Gospel, a voice comes from the cloud saying, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him" (Mark 9:7). Lent is a particularly

appropriate time to listen to Jesus. Last week we heard him proclaim, "Repent, and believe in the Gospel." Next week we will hear him say "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace." During this penitential season we reflect on when we have disobeyed or turned away from God and we ask for forgiveness.
