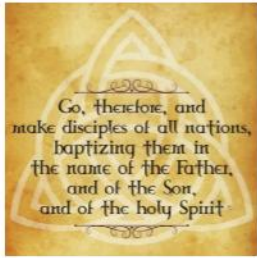




Holy Trinity

- We also have several phone numbers which are no longer valid, so we need everyone to update their contact information.

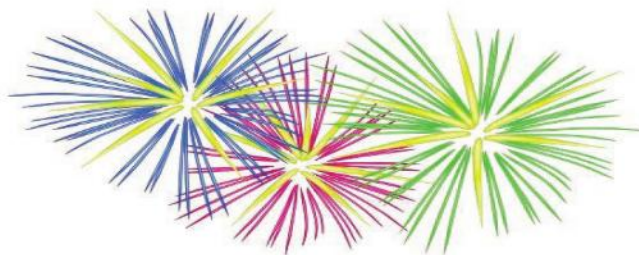

Many of these people are vulnerable to abuse because they live alone or are dependent on someone else for their care. Texas law requires the reporting of elder abuse or the suspicion of elder abuse. *If you know of someone who cannot care for himself/herself, or who is being abused, neglected or exploited*, whether they live alone or with a spouse or caregiver, you are required to report the abuse.
